Buryatia is located in the southern part of Eastern Siberia, east of Lake Baikal (60% of the shoreline).



It borders the Republic of Tuva, Irkutsk Oblast, and Zabaykalsky Krai, and to the south, it borders Mongolia.



3,485 km - the length of the Russian-Mongolian border.




The forest fund extends over 29,701 hectares, covering 84.2% of the republic's territory.







Increase in the Number of Cargo Aircraft at Baikal Airport Over 4 Years




